

Thirtieth Week in Ordinary Time

The Gospel Reading in the **All Saints' Day Mass (November 1, 12:15pm, HFS hall)** recounts the occasion Jesus addressed the multitude gathered on a hill in northern Israel, in the Korazim Plateau, his famous Sermon on the Mount. His message rings true even in today's world, one that we at Holy Family try to instill in our students through the <u>3 Marist Virtues</u> of humility, simplicity, and modesty.

- ★ Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- ★ Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- ★ Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.
- ★ Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- ★ Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
- ★ Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.
- ★ Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.
- ★ Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

These "Beatitudes" or "Brief Blessings" provide solace in times of hardship and advice on what truly matters in life- being humble, merciful and peaceful. Making good choices and doing the right thing, even when others ridicule us or do not understand. Placing love of God and our neighbour above material things.

Unfortunately due to low numbers the Young Engineers Club is <u>cancelled</u> for Term 4.


