






The St Vincent de Paul Society founded in Paris in 1833 by Frederic Ozanam, was established along with those like him who wanted to put their Catholic faith into action.

Frederic Ozanam, who was born in Milan, Italy in 1813, as a young student in Paris, had to walk through the poorer areas of the city on his way to university lectures. He was deeply moved by the sight of impoverished families who had been left without income and support after a cholera epidemic in 1832.

A comment by an anti-religious debating society opponent: 'You are right Ozanam when you speak of the past! In former times Christianity worked wonders, but what is it doing for mankind now? And you, who pride yourself on your Catholicity, what are you doing now for the poor? Show us your works' propelled him to action.

On 23 April 1833 he gathered some friends to plan how they could help the poor. After the meeting, Frederic and his flat mate took their winter wood supply and gave it to a widow.

Their group was asked: 'What can seven young men hope to achieve in alleviating the suffering in Paris?'.

However, with a determined zeal to bear witness to their Christian ethos, the group named themselves after St Vincent de Paul, Patron Saint of Christian charity and worked to assist the poor. Initiated in such humble beginnings, the Society now helps over 30 million people worldwide every day.

We, at Holy Family love to be part of this wonderful legacy. Our Stage 3 Mini Vinnies members enjoy advertising the Mission Days by creating posters and running their own stalls.

PARENTS CHECK THE CHECK







In June 2013 legislation changed, requiring people working or volunteering with children under 18 years to have a Working With Children Check.

The legislated phase-in for existing employees and volunteers in education took place between 1 April 2016 and 31 March 2017. This included people working in private tuition and coaching - many of whom are self employed. This sector will now be subject to the Office of the Children's Guardian compliance program.

What does this mean for parents?

Parents engaging tutors for their children should be asking the tutor to provide a Working With Children Check application or clearance number - then verifying that number online.

Verifying a clearance online is quick and easy, and ensures that a Working With Children Check clearance is
